



Director's Note

A few years after I wrote one of my grad school thesis projects (a screenplay), I decided to write an extensive background story on the lead character. When the writing was done, I realized that Naomi Morris' background story was, also, a story of its own. I entitled the short script, "Bobby Lee Blood," and began developing it as a one-woman show. Eventually, I produced, directed, and starred in the show with five other actors; I played Emma Jean Johnson.

Over the years, I've completed several re-writes of **Bobby Lee Blood**. I've realized that the best version of this story is the one in which I didn't try to clean up the characters, the language, or their lives. The story was more poignant to me when I let the characters be authentic. Most of the fourteen characters in **Bobby Lee Blood** face some of life's biggest (often, silent) challenges, including issues related to PTSD, identity, faith, and mental illness.

For the 2024 Orlando Fringe Festival production of BLB, I thought that it would be awesome to tell this story with two different casts, as the issues of this show are colorless. The discussions that I've had with the actors as they developed their characters have been thought-provoking and enlightening. I am thankful that each of the actors agreed to be a part of this production journey. They have made me giggle and laugh out loud so many times. They've inspired me with their courage in bringing these characters (who are often bad-mannered, ill-tempered, and uncouth) to life.

My husband/partner/best friend, Vince Farmer, continues to challenge and encourage me to follow my creative instincts and dreams. When I said, "I think I want to do this with two casts...," he egged me on and said, "Do it!"...even though it was going to cost *mas dinero*. He is continues to be such a dream. I am thankful.

I would like to thank the audience of this show. I do not take it lightly when someone spends their time and money on a SparKyl Entertainment, Inc. production.
